- Impact of climate change and pollution on agricultural productivity and ecological resilience
- The challenges of antimicrobial resistance in agricultural, veterinary, and medical practices
- Artificial intelligence, education, and research in the service of "One Health" in sub-Saharan Africa.

Open sessions will also be organized.
